

CONSTRUCTION INSPECTORS-SEASONAL

Job Description

Construction Inspection positions are seasonal (April through November) and duration is based on type of project, location and weather.

Candidate will inspect and monitor construction activities at various civil engineering related projects including sewer and water distribution systems. Responsibilities include recording and documenting daily field activities, completing daily field inspection reports, annotating field drawings, maintaining photographic logs and communicating results to supervisor per NYSDOT Manual of Uniform Record Keeping (MURK).

Candidate will evaluate whether construction conforms to plans and specifications, conduct field measurements to establish quantities for pay item documentation and inspect work zones for proper maintenance and protection of traffic (MPT) set up per NYSDOT Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD).

Qualifications

Candidate will work under limited supervision and will require the knowledge of general construction materials, methods, and equipment used in heavy construction and have the ability to read and interpret construction plans and drawings, contract provisions, and specifications.

Candidate must be familiar with NYSDOT Standards such as Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), Manual on Uniform Record Keeping (MURK) and Standard Specifications for Construction and Materials.

Additional Requirements:

Associates degree in a civil technology or construction related field with a minimum of 4 years work experience in construction inspection, such as sewer and water distribution systems, stormwater drainage systems, earthwork and asphalt pavement OR High School Diploma or equivalent with a minimum of 8 years work experience in civil engineering or related construction inspection.
